Help Birds on Their Journey

The Central Valley is part of the [Pacific Flyway](#), a major migration route where millions of birds travel each year between breeding and wintering grounds. Along the way, these birds rely on healthy habitats to rest, refuel, and find shelter.

You can help support migrating birds right at home by keeping cats indoors, cleaning bird feeders regularly, adding window decals to reduce collisions, and turning off unnecessary outdoor lights at night. Planting native species, including those available through [SRT's Dry Creek Native Plant Nursery](#), can also provide valuable food and habitat for birds and the insects they depend on.

Small actions can help create safer spaces for birds as they move through the Central Valley and beyond. Explore more ways to support migrating birds and make your home a more welcoming habitat.
